Claim Period

Documents required for a valid claim of entitlement

- 1. Proof of ID - valid photo card driving licence or passport
2. Proof of address (two utility bills in the applicants name no older than 3 months)
3. The Vehicle Registration document for the above named seized vehicle
4. Valid Insurance documents
5. Written proof of authority to act as agent if acting in a representative capacity (valid power of attorney plus item 3 and 4 above and proof of ID and address of the agent)

**Unclaimed Property – Important, Sale, Disposal or Destruction of Vehicle**

Once this Notice has been published and served in accordance with regulations and

- a) The claim period has ended and no claim has been made
- b) A claim was made within the claim period but the seizure authority determined that the claimant was not entitled or
- c) A duty to return arose but has ceased in accordance with regulation 19

**The Seizure Council may immediately dispose, sell or destroy seized property**
