<p>In the library there will be shelves of books and DVDs</p>	
<p>I can sit in a chair to read a book</p>	

I can borrow a book or DVD and take it home with me



If I want to borrow a book I will talk to a member of the library staff



The staff will show me how to borrow the book or DVD and tell me when I need to bring it back to the library



The library will also have some computers



The computers are free to use



To use the computers I will need to reserve a time, wait for one to become available or, if I'm under 18 I will need to talk to a member of staff



When I have finished I will leave the library
