

# Targeted Youth Support Services - Intervention Process

**YOUNG PERSON** aged 8 to 19 years – identified as having multiple needs and there are concerns that they are vulnerable to adverse outcomes

**NOMINATING PERSON / AGENCY** – can be Self / Parent or Carer / School / Police / ASB Unit / Social Services/Connexions PA's /EWO

**NOMINATION FORM COMPLETED** – must have a CAF or Pre-CAF or any other nationally recognised assessment. ( however CAF assessment is preferable) attached completed by the nominator. Must be signed by Parent / Carer, Nominator and Young Person

**COMPLETED NOMINATION FORM** – sent to relevant Hub. Nomination forms are received and logged by TYS Admin Officers and given to TYS Hub Leads (all nominations require a pre-CAF, CAF or any other nationally recognised assessment.)

## VERIFICATION / ALLOCATION MEETINGS

– held every fortnight to discuss all received nominations and allocate appropriately

### ENHANCED TYS

Highest need / most complex cases

### STANDARD TYS

Less complex cases

**Lead Professional allocated** – Completes an ONSET, CAF or Initial Assessment to ascertain .... Is the YP suitable for TYS ?

## MONTHLY HUB PANEL MEETING

### “Full Case Discussion”

These are young people who have multiple issues and require a multi agency discussion to develop a joint holistic plan.

### “Mention Only”

These are young people who are discussed with partners, in order to ascertain any additional information held by agencies that could support the development of Individual Action Plans.

### “Information Only”

These are YP who are engaging in TYS services and are listed so that the partner organisations know that these young people are being supported within the TYS programme and that if they do develop any further issues/ problems that they can pass the information on to TYS.

**ENHANCED TYS Interventions:** 1:1s, Core Sessions and Open Access YDSS and VCS Positive Activities. May also access NACRO interventions.

**STANDARD TYS Interventions:** 1:1s, Rolling Induction, Core Sessions and Open Access Positive Activities coordinated by the allocated key worker in line with the IAP. May also access YDSS TYS interventions.

## Partnering Organisations

Will support TYS delivery across the District Hubs.

They will offer innovative services and interventions needed to fill gaps in provision identified by YDSS, NACRO and other sources.

All Partner Organisations will follow the NACRO procurement procedure, including the use of the Invitation to Quote Pro-forma which will specify what interventions are required. The responses will be scored for best value, innovation and quality of provision.
