

## **Workshop Visioning Exercise – The Results**

### **Theme 1 – Young people being involved designing and developing cultural activities**

- Young people being asked what they want and involved in the decision-making process
- Young people being fully involved in designing and delivering Wakefield's cultural offer
- Young people having a choice in and say about how money is spent

### **Theme 2 – Tools to enable young people to better access quality cultural activities**

- Making it easier and cheaper for young people to access cultural activities – free use would be best as this would encourage involvement/use
- Sustainable long-term funding in place for cultural activities/organisations so they can focus on delivery
- Improved transport links within the district and free transport to all cultural venues/activities/facilities

### **Theme 3 – Raising awareness among young people of what is on offer culturally**

- Clear user-friendly information on opportunities to participate
- A central point of information for young people where information can be added and updated

### **Theme 4 – Changing and enhancing our cultural offer for young people**

- More music provision and venues
- Wider choice of quality venues, especially for under 18s
- Multi-purpose community facilities including a new rugby stadium which can also be used for cultural activities

### **Theme 5 – Equipping young people with the knowledge and confidence to access opportunities**

- All schools being actively involved in providing cultural opportunities/activities
- Compulsory culture general studies lessons throughout schools
- Out of classroom learning throughout region and beyond for young people and for educators including national relevance training and resource systems
- All schools accessing the cultural learning activities on offer
