“Yesterday we held a very positive Council meeting to discuss the future of the Yorkshire Libraries and Information (YLI) Music and Drama Collection. At the meeting it was agreed:

- We continue to recognise the significance locally and nationally of this collection.
- We are committed to ensuring that it remains available on a sustainable basis to the public.
- We have already received some expressions of interest and are inviting further such expressions from groups for the future provision of the music and drama service from April 1st 2012 by 30th November 2011.

“We will do all that we can to try and find a solution to this issue, so that alternative provision can be arranged in time for when current arrangements end.”
