Additional courses

Watersports courses can be organised on request from individuals or groups (e.g. youth groups, school groups, ethnic minorities, women's and disabled groups). These courses can be organised at times to suit the individual or group needs.

Alternatively private instruction is available for individuals or groups. This can be for instruction or for qualification assessments. A 1 1/2 hour session costs £37.50 plus the hire cost of equipment or launch fee of private equipment

In all cases Pugneys Country Park will adhere to the following instructor - student ratios

About the courses

Pugneys Country Park is a Royal Yachting Association and British Canoe Union recognised teaching Centre. The courses offered are from the national windsurfing, dinghy sailing or canoe coaching schemes. All the instructors are highly qualified through the appropriate governing body and have considerable experience in teaching at Pugneys.

Since August 1999 Pugneys Country Park has been working under the guidelines of the Adventure Activities Licensing Authority (AALA). This covers the provision of activities for children up to the age of 18 years. (licence No. L6791/R2088)

What to bring

For the dinghy sailor waterproofs and warm clothing along with Plimsolls or wetboots. For the windsurfers wetsuits are available though plimsolls or wetboots are required. Showers and changing rooms are available so towel, toiletries and a complete change of clothing would be handy.

Catering is available on site, though you may wish to bring a packed lunch as ample picnic facilities are available.

Log books and Handbooks are available from reception at the Park.

Participants who already possess an RYA logbook will have their books updated by the course instructor at the end of the course.

Disability access

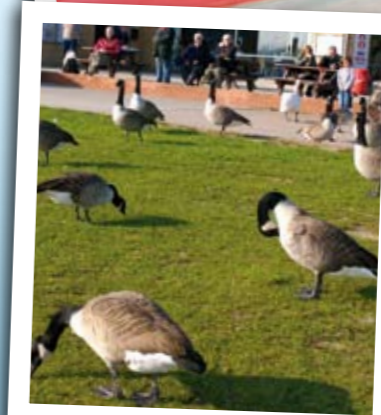
The centre is accessible for people with disabilities, entry for wheelchair users is good. Dedicated changing rooms and toilets are provided.

The centre has 2 dinghies for use by people with a disability and special tuition can be arranged.

The park also includes an accessible trim-trail, which has been designed for use by individuals or organised groups.

Pugneys Country Park is working toward further improving the access for people with disabilities. Plans are in place to improve the access from the jetties to the lake and we will be pursuing recognition for the Royal Yachting Association Sailability standard.

Work is also planned to provide access to the bird hide by improvement works to the footpath.

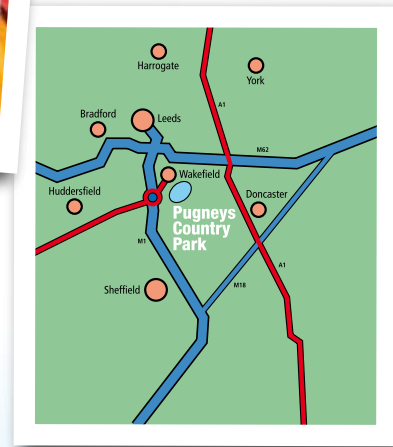
