- A folder / portfolio to keep your work in order
- Your tutor will inform you of further resources required for the course

- Further materials and equipment may cost from £40 dependent on your personal project
- This is an accredited course covering 4 units of work. Completion of all units is required to complete the certificate
- There will be a design unit included in the course
- You will be expected to develop a portfolio of evidence
- Homework will be required at approximately 3 to 4 hours per week
