What will I learn?

- How to be the nominated first aider in the workplace
- The roles and responsibilities of an emergency first aider
- How to administer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- How to deal with selected first aid incidents such as:
 - Unconscious casualties
 - Choking, bleeding, shock
 - Other minor injuries

Who is it for?

Anyone aged 19+. There is no fee remission for this course.

Where and when will it take place?

Courses start throughout the year at various locations across the Wakefield District.

What do I need to bring with me?

Pen and notebook

Important Information about your Course:

- You must attend the full session
- The course requires you to be physically able to perform certain techniques eg CPR as you will be required to kneel on the floor and perform chest compressions etc.
- It meets all the requirements of the Health & Safety (First Aid) Regulations 1981 and the Health and Safety Executive. Enabling staff to act as the nominated first aider in the workplace.
- Assessment activities will include demonstration and observation of practical activities and the completion of some short written and multiple choice questions. Therefore you require a good level of written English.
- You will need to provide proof of identity in the form of photographic ID at the first class. This could be a passport, photographic driving licence or work ID badge etc
