Courses start from Foundation up to Level 2

What will I learn?

- **Get Started-** (Foundation) to learn basic skills such as spelling, speaking and listening to others, reading and writing simple texts.
- **Get On-** (E2-E3) for those who want to build on their basic skills, use speaking and listening skills with others, spelling strategies, develop and improve reading and writing skills and use of grammar.
- **Move On-** (L1-L2) for those who wish to progress further: developing speaking and listening skills to use with different audiences, improving presentation skills, correct use of grammar and using English skills in work and life.

Who is it for?

Anyone aged 19+, from beginners to those who want to improve on previous skills. **This course is free.**

Where and when will it take place?
