What will I learn?

- Knowledge, skills and understanding of mathematical methods and concepts.
- The ability to apply mathematical techniques to solve problems.
- Reasoning and thinking skills needed for progression into higher/ further education and jobs.

Who is it for?

This course is for anyone aged 19+, who is working at or above Level 2 in Numeracy, who wants to work towards a recognised GCSE qualification. This is a fast track course studied over 1 year. **This course is free.**

Where and when will it take place?

What do I need to bring with me?

- Pen and notebook.
- Materials as directed at Enrolment Workshop.
- A basic folder to keep your work in.

Important Information about your Course:

- You will undertake an assessment activity prior to the course starting to ensure that your existing maths skills are already at level 2.
- This is a demanding, fast track course, which requires regular attendance
- You will be required to undertake at least 3 hours of homework each week and would be responsible for catching up on work from any missed sessions.
- Exams are usually held towards the end of May and beginning of June. Confirmation of exact dates will be given later in course. Please avoid taking holidays in this period as no other exam dates will be available.
- Additional class support may be available.
- Course books and equipment will be available for loan or purchase. Please ask at the centre.
- You can expect quality teaching and learning from us.
- You will be provided with individual feedback on your progress throughout your course.
