


# Cutting Men's Hair



## **Take a step into Men's Grooming.**

Barbering services are increasingly in high demand. The men's grooming market has been growing annually for more than a decade and further growth is expected in the services required in both specialist barber shops and general hairdressing salons.

## **What will I learn?**

This 10-week course will cover traditional cutting techniques and aims to introduce the basic skills needed to offer cutting services to male clients.

The course will include a wide variety of tutor demonstrations and learners carrying out taught techniques on block heads. More advanced learners will be challenged to perform services on real paying clients. Techniques taught will include scissor & clipper over comb, short-layered looks, and texturizing, basic clipper work using guards and blending.

## Who is it for?

Learners who have hairdressing, barbering or previous cutting experience who want to further develop their skills. Anyone aged 19+, you may be entitled to a free course or financial help with childcare, equipment, or fees.

## Where and when will it take place?

Courses take place at various dates throughout the year within commercial salons based at our Manygates Centre.

## What do I need to bring with me?

- Learners will be expected to bring their own clients from week 7 onwards.

## Important Information about your Course:

- You are expected to attend and be punctual to all sessions.
- You will be asked to purchase a professional kit. Further information and order forms will be given at interview including the possibility of funding for this depending on your circumstances. You will be expected to wear a plain black short sleeved T shirt, black trousers and full black shoes to all salon sessions.
- Stylist's and barbers work in close contact with clients from different age groups and backgrounds. Good social and interpersonal skills, discretion and respect for others are important characteristics. You will also need to have physical stamina as you are often on your feet all day
- The course is non-accredited, however your progress is assessed via the completion of simulated practical assessments carried out following training and practice. Theory work is assessed through completion of weekly course work and covers essential working practices and procedures but is not assessed.
