- Assessment is through the completion of project work, written assignments and the completion of structured questions and therefore you are required to attend every week/session. A good level of spoken and written English is required.
- This is an accredited level 2 course and the first 4 weeks of the course will form an introduction which will assess your suitability and commitment to be successful on the course. At this point a review will be undertaken with you and the course tutor to agree the most appropriate progression route.
