What will I learn?

How to:

- Explore design and colour using a variety of art materials displayed within a portfolio which will enable you to create your own designs.
- Use experimental techniques such as dyeing, block printing and fabric collage.
- Produce a portfolio of work showing a range of sample ideas and development, through to final project.
- Create two fashion items or two pieces of interior furnishings as your final projects.

You will select from fashion or interior textiles – your tutor will advise whether you will undertake level 1 or level 2

Who is it for?

Anyone aged 19+, who would like to learn a variety of sewing skills within a structured programme of learning - you may be entitled to a free course.

Where and when will it take place?

Courses start throughout the year at various locations across the Wakefield District. Please contact Manygates Adult Education Centre on the number below for further information.

What do I need to bring with me?

- A notebook and pen
- A folder / portfolio to keep your work in order
- A sewing kit (soft tape measure, pins, needles, threads, scissors – large and small if possible – (some items are available in class); items not required for the first session.
- You can bring your own sewing machine if you wish (not required for the first session)

Important Information about your Course:

- You are expected to attend every week/session
- Further materials and equipment will cost from £50 dependent on your personal projects
- This is an accredited course covering 4 units of work. Completion of all units is required to complete the Certificate.
- You will be expected to develop a portfolio of evidence.
- Homework will be required at approximately 2-4 hours per week.
- There will be a design unit included in the course involving art materials; you do not need to be able to draw.
