Anyone aged 19+, you may be entitled to a free course or financial help with childcare, equipment, or fees. You will need to attend an interview to assess your suitability for the course.

- There is a mandatory interview for anyone wanting to attend this course
- You are expected to attend every week/session
- If not already employed within the sector, you will be required to find a voluntary work placement within an appropriate school setting for a minimum 5 hours per week throughout the duration of the course
- It would be beneficial to purchase a course text book costing approximately £28. Your course tutor can provide details.
- You will be required to meet the requirements of an enhanced DBS.
- Assessment will be via assignments, case studies, observations of work practice, expert witness testimonies, and professional discussions.
