When I get to the library I will see a desk



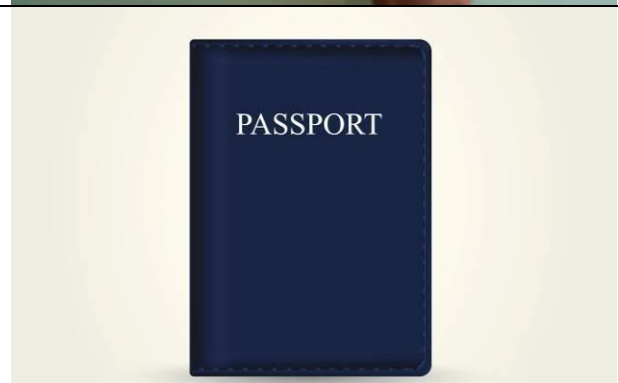
I will talk to someone who works there to become a member of the library

I will sign a form, this makes me a member of the library and I will be given a library card



When I visit the library

I can sit in a chair to read a book



I can borrow a book and take it home with me



If I want to borrow a book I will talk to a member of the library staff



The staff will show me how to borrow the book, and tell me when I need to bring it back to the library



The library will also have some computers



The computers are free to use. You only have to pay for anything you want to print.



To use the computers I will need to wait for one to be available or talk to a member of staff



When I have finished I will leave the library
