

## Walton Neighbourhood Development Plan

### Decision Statement published pursuant to section 38A (9) and (10) Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) and Regulations 19 and 20 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended)

On 13 April 2016 Wakefield Council resolved to make the Walton Neighbourhood Development Plan under Section 38A (4) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended). The Walton Neighbourhood Development Plan now forms part of the Development Plan for the Wakefield Metropolitan District.

#### Reasons for decision:

In accordance with section 38A (4) Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 the Council is legally obliged to make the Plan as it has been through a successful referendum and does not breach, or would otherwise be incompatible with, any EU obligation or any of the Convention rights (within the meaning of the Human Rights Act 1998).


